Chaperone Agreements:

_____ Stay with your participants at all times.

_____ Engage by participating in activities and encourage listening during informational periods such as the tour.

_____ Ensure p[participants of the collection and are not reaching under or over barriers to touch the collection. There are many harmful materials such as broken glass or rusted metal in the collection that can harm students.

_____ Monitor food/beverages being consumed. Only secured water bottles are allowed in the exhibit/Neon Boneyard. Snacks or lunch may not be consumed in the museum, but you may use the park we have on campus.

_____ Chaperones are not permitted to bring outside guests such as infants, toddlers, or other students who are not in the class while acting as a chaperone on the field trip.

_____ Chaperones are within the ratio of chaperones to the group. If chaperones are over ratio there has been an approval by The Neon Museum staff and payment has been made by teacher/lead chaperone.
